

## THE RESEARCH OF RATIONAL USE OF CULTURAL PASTURES

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**Summary.** It would be rational to graze a cultural pasture with an average productivity of 3000-3500 feeding units per hectare 5 times a season. This exploitation of a pasture improves the grass consumption by 10-15 %, encouraging the growth of white clover in pasturable grass and increasing its nutritional value. The best time for grazing the grass is when its height achieves 12-17 cm. The grass of later phases and higher than 30 cm should be cut for winter forages.
