

PROTECTION OF SOIL AND GROUND WATER FROM POLLUTION WITH MANURE BACTERIA

Summary. New-settler farmers on old farm-steads use wells the water of which is polluted by *E. coli*, ammonium and nitrates. Soil, ground water and wells are polluted by the untidily stored manure. This sanitary problem can be resolved by constructing typical multi-compartment manure-yards.
