

MORPHOLOGICAL CHANGES OF GENITALS IN COWS AND HEIFERS IN THE CASE OF SYMPTOMATIC BARRENNESS

Summary. Diseases of digestive organs in cows and heifers negatively effect the generative functions of the ovary, the uterus glands, the covering epithelium and the blood vessels. The negative impact in cows resulted in atresion of follicles, dystrophy of the epithelium glands of the uterus and obliteration of the blood vessels of the uterus. In heifers the pathological factors of the diseases of digestive organs inhibited the development of genitals and caused atrophic phenomena of uterus structures.
