

TREATMENT OF OTITIS EXTERNA BY MEANS OF NOVOCAIN BLOCK

Summary. A new treatment of otitis externa by means of a Novocain block is described. The lateral internal auricular nerve, the middle internal auricular nerve, the caudal internal auricular nerve are being blocked, as well as the branches of the auriculotemporal nerve and the auriculopalpebral nerve, going to the external ear. Clinical research demonstrated that using the block considerably fastens the process of healing and can be successful when no other treatment is effective.
