THE IMMUNOGENIC PROPERTIES OF CHICKEN HERPES VIRUS RISPENS STRAIN

Summary. Marek's disease is worldwide distributed poultry disease, which is common in Lithuania. Different vaccines are used for prevention of Marek's disease. The immunogenic properties and efficacy of chicken *Herpes* virus strain *Rispens* CVI-988 against Marek's disease was investigated, 9520 chicken were used in a trial. Vaccine made from virus strain *Rispens* CVI-988 have shown 100% efficacy against Marek's disease.
