

INVESTIGATION OF DIRECTIONS AND DEVELOPMENT OF FODDER ECONOMY, DURING INTENSIFICATION OF CATTLE-BREEDING

Summary. Cattle-breeding is one of the most important branches of animal-breeding in the country. Fodder is one of the factors of its success. Only full value, qualitative, inexpensive fodder enables to get cheap and competitive production of cattle-breeding [9].

Investigation of fodder economy and directions lead to regulations of fodder production development in the country for the nearest year, setting forth the requirements, principal directions, ways and means for realization of this purpose.

Study of milk and meat production strategies were analysed, the program of agricultural product export development, the state of cattle-breeding in recent years was carried-out.

The work analyses fodder development prospects until the year 2005.

It is supposed, that until then both the activity of farmers, and cattle-breeding and fodder production market will have been balanced and the directions of fodder production will not change significantly after the year 2000.
